### **ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS (2)**

- Value \$2,534\* (or 50% of Tuition Donation & Attendance Fees)
- Available for Year 9 students only and available for three years subject to:
  - outstanding academic achievement;
  - an excellent attitude to learning (specific criteria will be made available to successful candidates).
- Students may be eligible for Senior College Academic Scholarships in Years 12 and 13 (criteria to be made available in Year 11).

### **GENERAL EXCELLENCE SCHOLARSHIPS (2)**

- Value \$2,534\* (or 50% of Tuition Donation & Attendance Fees)
- General Excellence Scholarships will be awarded to students who show outstanding prowess in a sporting / musical / cultural area(s) and a positive attitude to learning.
- Available for Year 9 students only and available for three years subject to:
  - Academic reports indicating a continuing positive attitude towards study;
  - A high level of achievement / aptitude in the student's chosen activity area(s);
  - A record of full and enthusiastic participation in the wider life of the school and fulfilling the school's expectations as a role model to other students.
- Students may be eligible for Senior College Academic Scholarships in Years 12 and 13 (criteria to be made available in Year 11).

### **Procedures**

- Application to be made on the application form available from the school or on line at [www.rathkeale.school.nz](http://www.rathkeale.school.nz) and accompanied by the following:
  - The applicant's most recent school report;
  - A resume (handwritten by the student) of the applicant's academic achievements or;
  - A resume (handwritten by the student) of the applicant's sporting / musical / cultural (any or all or other non academic) achievements.
- A short list of candidates will be determined from the applications received.
- Short listed candidates will be advised and permission will be sought to contact their current teachers(s) and/or the current school principal.
- Short listed candidates will sit an examination and attend an interview at a date in June to be advised.

## **FOR ALL APPLICANTS**

- To be considered for a 2011 Scholarship, provisional enrolment must be received by Friday 21 May, 2010.
- A short list will be drawn up of the most suitable candidates based on their written applications. Shortlisted candidates will be advised by Friday 28 May, 2010.
- The Principal or Deputy Principal will interview all short listed candidates.
- Scholarship winners will be announced by Friday 11 June, 2010.
- Students can apply for an Academic Scholarship and / or a General Excellence Scholarship but they will only be eligible for one award.

## **OTHER SCHOLARSHIPS AND SUPPORT (FUNDED BY VARIOUS TRUSTS)**

The following are able to be applied for as indicated:

- **Papawai Kaikokiri Trust Scholarship**
  - Apply to Papawai Kaikokiri Trust Board PO Box 2019 Masterton
  - Must be of Ngati Kahungunu Ki Wairarapa or Rangitane O Wairarapa descent
- **Mapihi Financial Support** (Ministry of Education)
  - Apply to the Ministry of Education PO Box 1666, Wellington Phone 04 463 8000
  - Students must be boarders. And funding reconsidered on a term by term basis pending satisfactory progress
- Various Other **Maori Education Trust Secondary Scholarships**
  - Apply to the Maori Education Trust PO Box 11 255 Wellington
  - Available to all levels of students pending certain criteria
- **St Martin's Bursary** – Awarded to a student from the Mangaweka district who is a boarder at the school. The value of the Bursary (yet to be confirmed) will offset some of the cost of the Tuition fees and Donation Dues. The Bursary is for the tenure of the student's time at Rathkeale College subject to satisfactory academic performance. Preference will be given to students of Anglican background and academic, sporting and cultural strengths will be considered. Applications by letter submitted by the end of October will be considered.
- **Other Assistance** – The school also receives funds from various anonymous sources to support families in financial need in order that their son(s) may continue their education at Rathkeale College. A condition for support is that students are currently enrolled, that the determination for the award is made by the principal and that the students receiving assistance shall also remain anonymous.
